Abstract The St. Aloysius Orphanage was established in 1837 in Cincinnati, OH. The St. Aloysius Orphanage records include vital records for the orphans, operational and financial material, publications, and other material. Also in this collection are board minutes and membership material for the St. Aloysius Orphan Society and Ladies Auxiliary: two organizations that financed and managed the orphanage.

Scope and Content

The St. Aloysius Orphanage Records consist of 97 boxes (71 cubic feet). The collection consists of two main types of material: vertical files and horizontal ledgers or scrapbooks. The records are organized first into series and sub-series and then by material type and lastly chronologically, unless otherwise stated. Most of the records written before 1920's are in German. Also many of the older ledgers are in poor condition and may not be available for unrestricted use.

Series 1, Vital Records, is divided into five subseries. Most of the material documenting the children who stayed at the orphanage is located in this series. Generally records of the children are minimal in the first 80 years of the orphanage.

Sub-series 1A, Census/Admission and Dismissals, documents the children admitted to the orphanage. The census files are mostly just lists of the children related to their school grade or age group. The admission and dismissals files are also lists of children, but they include information on the children. The information can range greatly. Some children have exact admission dates, birth dates, and to whom they were dismissed. Some children have relatively little information. The vertical files are in English. Most of the horizontal ledgers are in German. If translations are available, they are listed on the container list. See Note to Researchers for detailed instructions on finding children in the orphanage.

Sub-series 1B, Orphan files, documents the biographical information for children who stayed at the orphanage. Each file usually documents an entire family. The earliest date on the files usually indicates when the child was admitted. Letters written by the children or requesting information about former children were also placed in student files. There are three subgroupings in this subseries: early orphan files, later orphan files, and legal material from the orphan files. The files are organized alphabetically within their subgroupings. The early orphan files generally document children who were admitted from 1845 to 1899 and have sparse information. Some information that can be found in these files are birth dates, admission dates, parental information, baptismal information, and some dismissal information. Most of the early orphan files are in German. The files with 2010 and 2011 dates have translations. The later orphan files generally document children who were admitted between 1900 and the mid-1990s. The orphan files of children admitted between 1900 and 1920 have similar information to the early orphan files and they are mostly in German. Starting in the mid-1920s more information was kept on the children. In-depth family backgrounds, health records, school records, and material gathered by Catholic Charities can be found in the later student files. Photographs can be found in some of the later student files starting in the mid-1940s through the 1970s. The legal material from the orphan files are mostly court documents. See the finding aid for folders that are related.

Please note: Records in the Orphan files that are less than 70 years old are restricted for privacy reasons. Only people obtaining their own records may have access when an ID is presented.

Sub-series 1C, Other Student lists, documents the children in the orphanage through various reports and lists. Items that are of particular interest are the wage home files and personality reports.

Sub-series 1D, Guardianship and Estate material, documents various families histories and legal proceedings involving the children in the orphanage. These records are from the first 100 years of the orphanage and they may provide more depth to the early student files.

Sub-series 1E, Religious ceremony records, documents baptisms, communions, confirmations, and marriages performed at St. Aloysius. These records do not appear to be complete.

Series 2, Administration, is divided into three subseries. Most of the material documenting the daily running of the orphanage is located in this series. Since the St. Aloysius Orphan Society was the administrative body for the orphanage there is a grey area where the Orphan Society begins and the orphanage ends. There may be additional administration information within series 5, St. Aloysius Orphan Society.

Sub-series 2A, Operations, is divided into four subgroupings: general operations, building and maintenance, correspondence, and inquiries. This sub-series is organized first by subgrouping and then chronologically. Items of note within the general operations documents are building leases, contracts for the Sisters of Notre Dame, lists of personnel, and childcare handbooks. Most of the material in building and maintenance is from the 1900s. There are a few documents from the very late 1880s. The correspondence subgrouping is relatively small. It does not appear to be a complete record of the correspondence at the orphanage. The inquiries subgrouping consists of inquiries from former residence of the orphanage and their relatives.

Sub-series 2B, Financial, is divided into five subgroupings: general financial, cashbooks, children's money, bequests, and investments. The general financial subgrouping has vertical files and horizontal ledgers that document assets, expenses, liabilities, and income. The cashbooks are very large ledgers showing the various cash transactions at the orphanage. The children's money ledgers document the orphanage's practice of investing children's money. Older children were sent out into the community as apprentices and the money they earned was looked after by the orphanage. When the child was dismissed from the orphanage the money and any interest accrued was returned to the child. The bequests subgrouping is fairly small. It mostly documents material left to the orphanage in wills. The investments subgrouping documents 60 years of the orphanages investments. It consists of a bond register and bond investment pages.

Sub-series 2C, Events, documents the various events and celebrations used to fundraise for the orphanage. The two notable events are Orphan feast and Pal-Al-Soirée.

Series 3, Press and Publications, consists of the St. Aloysius Bulletin and newspaper clippings about the St. Aloysius Orphanage. The first St. Aloysius Bulletin was published in March 1914. This collection has copies starting in 1920. Some of the newspaper clippings may document the St. Aloysius Orphan society, the Ladies Auxiliary, or Catholic community.

Series 4, Histories and Anniversaries, documents the anniversaries of the orphanage starting with the 50th anniversary in 1887. The histories located in the souvenir programs are very informative. There are multiple personal accounts of time at the orphanage by former children and nuns.

Series 5, St. Aloysius Orphan Society, is divided into three subseries. Most of the material documents the operation of the society and not the orphanage, but there is some overlap. Meeting minutes, especially the older minutes, probably discussed operations at the orphanage as well as the dealings of the society.

Sub-series 5A, Meeting Minutes, is divided into four subgroupings: regular board meeting minutes, special committee meeting minutes, subcommittee meeting minutes, and other minutes. The regular board meeting minutes start with the first St. Aloysius Orphan Society meeting which met on January 27, 1837. The regular board meeting minutes continue through 1950. Extensive translations have not been completed for the meeting minutes, so the details of the special committee and the various subcommittees are not known. The regular meeting minutes seem to be the most complete records of all the meeting minutes.

Sub-series 5B, Membership/Dues, documents the members of the St. Aloysius Orphan Society and the dues they paid. The earliest records start in 1843. There are published rosters of members from 1898 to 1973, but there are some missing years. There are pages from ledgers and notecards that document deceased members, resigned members, and ladies auxiliary members from 1916 to 1996.

Sub-series 5C, General Orphan Society, documents the administrators of the society and memorials for members of the society.

Series 6, Ladies Auxiliary, documents the Ladies Auxiliary, a woman's organization,

which was created as a partner to the St. Aloysius Orphan Society, which was a male society. Material in this series includes, meeting minutes, member information, financial documents, card party fundraisers, correspondence, and newspaper clippings.

Historical/Biographical Information

1830 to 1840- Cincinnati population almost doubles. Many of the immigrants are German.

1832- Cholera epidemic overtakes Cincinnati

1834- Another episode of cholera breaks out

1835/1836- Children left homeless by the cholera epidemic are plentiful. There is only one Catholic orphanage, St. Peter's Orphan Asylum, but it only receives girls.

Late 1836- Father John Martin Henni, pastor of the newly organized, German-speaking, Holy Trinity Church and Holy Trinity School, begins holding private meetings with community members to discuss the orphaned boys of Cincinnati.

January 27, 1837- First public meeting of the St. Aloysius Orphan Society is held in the assembly room of the Holy Trinity School. The Society is formally organized.

1837 to June 1839- Orphans are placed in private homes. The Society pays for their maintenance.

July 20, 1837 to 1843- The Society publishes the *Wahrheitsfreund* (friendly truth) in order to raise funds for the orphanage. The publication was the first German Catholic publication in the United States.

May 18, 1839- The Society purchases a nine-room house at 6th and John Street to serve as an orphanage.

June 1839- Six boys, ages 3 to 10, move into the orphanage. Boys already in private homes are kept there. Only newly accepted boys are placed in the orphanage.

1842- Number of children in the orphanage increases to 29.

March 3, 1843- The St. Aloysius Orphan Society is incorporated.

April 1844- The Society purchased a new property on 4th Street, between Western Row (now Central Ave) and John Street, to accommodate the growing number of children accepted by the orphanage.

1846- Number of children in the orphanage increases to 53.

June 1849- First St. Aloysius Orphan Feast is held. This remains the largest fundraiser for the orphanage for over 100 years.

September 1849- 62.5 acres on Reading Road in Bond Hill is purchased for the orphanage's future home. The Society paid \$9,588 for the land. The country climate was considered healthier. The current St. Aloysius organization is still located on Reading Road in Bond Hill.

July 1, 1850- The Orphan Society opens an orphanage for German Catholic girls on Abigail Street (now E. 12th St.), between Spring and Pendleton Streets.

October 15, 1851- Fire nearly destroys the Fourth Street orphanage. Of the 108 boys in the orphanage at the time 3 perish in the fire. The orphans are moved to a temporary home on Sixth Street.

1852- The Fourth Street orphanage reopens after repairs are made. Boys and girls are admitted to the same location for the first time.

1856- A three story building is completed on the Bond Hill property. The construction costs were \$9,000. The boys of the orphanage move into the building.

1861- A large addition is added to the front of the original three story building. This addition becomes the main building. The construction costs were \$17,437. The girls of the orphanage move into the Bond Hill property.

1864/1865- Additional land is purchased and the Bond Hill property increases to 71.24 acres. The excess acreage is used to grow fruits and vegetables, and graze livestock making the orphanage self-sufficient.

1869- Wings are added to each side of the main building. The extra space is used for classrooms.

1875- A separate building containing the heating and gas plant, and laundry is built.

May 1, 1877- The Sisters of Notre Dame start working at the orphanage. There are over 200 children in the orphanage.

October 1891- Fire damages a large part of the main building. Recovery, aided by insurance coverage, allows for a rebuild and more. A third floor is added to both wings and a fourth floor is added to the main building. The iconic Mansard roof, dormer windows, and water tank, in the shape of a cupola with crowning golden cross, is also added to the building.

1892- The barn burn down killing most of the livestock. A brick barn is built as a replacement.

September 26, 1915- The Ladies Auxiliary is organized. Mrs. Joseph Berning is the first president.

1917- With America's entry into World War I increased anti-German sentiment leads to more Americanization of Cincinnati's German immigrant population. The Orphanage starts accepting children from all backgrounds.

1918- The orphanage is quarantined for 4 months during the influenza epidemic. Of the 300 children in the orphanage only 5 do not contract the flu. 4 children die during the epidemic. 3 children die later from complications. 5 Sisters contract the flu, but none die.

May 1920- The members of the Orphan society raise \$4,000 for the Sisters of Notre Dame in the German Motherhouse.

1920- The orphanage is completely wired for electricity, natural gas, and indoor plumbing.

1921 to 1923- A free standing chapel is constructed on the property. The old chapel is located inside the main building on the second and third floors. When the free standing chapel is completed the old chapel space is turned into dormitories for the children. The entire project cost \$60,000.

1924- The Ladies Auxiliary provides \$2,000 so a swimming pool and recreation rooms can be built for the children of the orphanage.

May 20, 1927- The first series of card parties are held by the Ladies Auxiliary. Eventually the multiple card parties evolve into one grand card party given each year on Washington's Birthday. They are a lucrative fundraiser for the orphanage for years to come.

Late 1920s- Admissions and dismissal into and out of the Orphanage transition over to Catholic Charities. Before Catholic Charities the St. Aloysius Orphan Society members arrange for admission of the children into the Orphanage. The members also dismiss the children to suitable homes or an arranged apprenticeship. The Catholic Charities assign a social worker to the orphanage for the first time.

1932- The St. Aloysius Orphan Band is established.

1936- Sister Mary Edwardine, Administrator of St. Aloysius Orphanage, receives a degree in Social Work from Catholic University of America.

January 1937- During the flood children from St. Joseph Orphanage are transferred to St. Aloysius until it is safe for them to return to their own home. Due to the flood anniversary celebrations for the orphanage are cancelled.

1937- Boy Scout Troop #387 is established on orphanage grounds.

1937- Life in the orphanage starts with Mass at 7:15am every day, but Wednesday and Sunday. Sunday Mass is at 7:30. Children sleep in dormitory styled housing of twenty to thirty beds per room. The children are organized into a 'group system'. Kindergarten aged and under are the only mixed sex group. The junior boys group includes grade 1 thru 2. The junior girls group include grade 1 thru 3. The intermediate boys group includes grade 3 thru 5. The intermediate girls includes grade 4 thru 6. The senior boys group includes grade 6 thru 8. The senior girls groups includes grade 7 thru 8. Brothers and sisters eat together at meal time. 'Group Sisters' are Nuns in charge of a group of children. They sleep in the same dormitory as their group of children. They served as a type of foster mother. Visitors to the orphanage are allowed every Sunday.

1937- 172 children in orphanage, 21 Sisters of Notre Dame.

1950s to 1970s- Orphanage begin to transition to meet the needs of more than just orphaned children. Children displaced by divorce and children suffering from behavioral and mental issues are accepted into the orphanage. The Orphan Society sends representatives from the staff of Notre Dame Sisters to attend the University of Chicago seminar on 'The Institution as a Treatment Center'.

Children in the orphanage are enrolled in neighborhood schools to ease their transition back into the mainstream. After this change only a small number of children are educated on the orphanage grounds and they are transferred to neighborhood schools as soon as they can be successful in a traditional classroom. Children in the orphanage are also allowed to visit family on weekends and over holiday breaks.

February 3, 1966- The brick barn burns down. The school bus, farm tractor, and Festival equipment are all destroyed. The barn is not rebuilt.

September 1967- The first Pal-Al-Soirée dinner dance is held. It is the other main fundraiser after the St. Aloysius Orphan Feast.

Mid-1960s- Nine families of Cuban children fleeing the Communist takeover are given safe harbor in St. Aloysius Orphanage

1970s to 1980s- The dormitory styled housing changes to apartment style housing. Each apartment has several bedrooms, large bathroom, laundry room, a complete kitchen, living room, and study areas. Each bedroom has only two children. It's thought that the apartments would provide more family-type units for children. Older children would act as big brother and sister and help train and care for younger children. In turn the older children would gain self-confidence and independence with the additional responsibilities. Individual and group therapy is introduced to St. Aloysius under the social worker and psychologist/psychiatrist supervision.

1987- St. Aloysius strives to keep children in their homes if at all possible. Five-day and seven-day living plans are offered to respond to families in crisis. St. Aloysius still operates as an orphanage when children need to be permanently removed from homes, but children don't typically stay for long periods of time like they once did. Foster and adoptive homes are sought out as soon as possible.

Note to Researchers **Procedure for researching a child thought to have been admitted to the Orphanage**

Researchers should first look through the compiled and translated records before attempting to look through the old and fragile original ledgers. The old ledgers are not always indexed and they are all in German. Finding children in these ledgers is very difficult. Follow the steps below to navigate the various resources:

1) Look in the orphan files, boxes 12 to 29. They are arranged alphabetically by the child's surname. For children who entered the orphanage before 1900 look in the early student files. For children who entered the orphanage after 1900 look in the later student files.

Please note: Records in the Orphan files that are less than 70 years old are restricted for privacy reasons. Only people obtaining their own records may have access when an ID is presented.

2) For children admitted from 1850 to 1925 next look in box 5 and 6. These files contain translations of 2 admission ledgers. The children are organized alphabetically within the translations. For boys admitted between 1862-1905 look at the translations of record book #2. For quick reference there is an index for record book #2 in box 5, folder 1. For girls admitted between 1850-1925 look at the translations of record book #3. Record book #3 also contains the records for boys admitted from 1906-1925.

3) For children admitted from 1837 to 1992 next look in box 2

and 3. The admission files are arranged by year. The researcher will need to have an idea of when the child was admitted to the orphanage. (Tip: Start looking around the time of a parent's death.) These files are extremely helpful for researchers looking for children admitted very early and after 1925.

4) After 1925 the admission of children into the orphanage was controlled by Catholic Charities, so the orphanage may not have detailed information. If the orphanage did receive the records they will be in the orphan files. If they are not present researchers may contact Catholic Services of Southwest Ohio for more details.

Once the child has been located by following steps 1 through 4 the researcher may request to look at the original ledgers. Requests for certain ledgers may be denied if the material is too fragile. Box 10, folders 1 and 2 contain the pages from a ledger detailing the boys admitted from 1839-1846. Box 7 contains the pages from Record Book #1 detailing the boys admitted from 1842-1862 (Note: there is no translation for this ledger). Box 8 contains the original Record Book #2. Please use the index for Record Book #2 in box 5, folder 1. Box 10, folders 3 and 4 contain pages from a ledger detailing the children admitted from 1908-1917.

Procedure for researching the dismissal of a child from the Orphanage

Dismissal is a term used when a child left the orphanage. The reason for dismissal varied greatly. Some children were dismissed to their parents/relatives, foster/adoptive parents, apprenticeships, wage homes/other institutions, or they simply aged out of the orphanage. Some children ran away frequently and they were labelled as dismissed after a final run. The dismissal records are not complete. Some children do not have dismissal records.

1) To find dismissal records for a child start by looking in box 2 and 3. The files are arranged by year, so the researcher will need to have an idea of when the child left the orphanage. (Tip: Most boys were dismissed in their early teens.)

2) Next look in box 30, folders 1 thru 4 for children who were dismissed to wage homes.

3) Only after completing steps 1 and 2, a researcher may request the ledgers in box 11. The ledger labelled volume #3 has dismissals from 1858-1917. The ledger labelled volume #4 has admissions and dismissals from 1871-1899. Both of the ledgers are in German and they do not have indexes.
